Kevin is an applied ethnologist whose main interests include the welfare and behaviour of farm and companion animals, with a focus on how a better understanding of animal learning and cognitive abilities can be used to improve welfare. Following a degree in Zoology, Kevin completed a PhD on the learning abilities and welfare of sheep at the Centre for Animal Welfare and Zoology (CAWA), University of Cambridge. Kevin later conducted research at CAWA on whether dogs can be trained to detect odours associated with human prostate cancer, in collaboration with dog trainers and the University of Nottingham. Kevin also has a strong interest in companion animal welfare and has worked for an animal charity to improve the welfare of a wide range of farmed species.
